Join Naturalist Jerry Hightower for a late day look at the beautiful Riparian Wetlands along the river in the Johnson Ferry South Area. Discover the sights, sounds, and signs of the abundant and diverse wildlife that inhabit and visit these extraordinary places. Experience the beauty of the colors, textures, and music of these magical habitats. With luck you might see a Great Blue Heron take flight, hear a Barred Owl call, or watch the tracks of a beaver disappear into deep water. Wander through these wetlands with Jerry and gain from his insightful knowledge acquired in 35 years of experience.

These wonderful evenings are very wet and very muddy! You will be wading in water up to your knees for most of the program. Long pants and lace on shoes that you don't mind getting wet and muddy are required. Repellant and a light jacket is advisable. Bring clean dry clothing in your vehicle for your ride home.

These *Sunset in the Swamp* programs are **FREE**, but reservations are required. Please call 678-538-1200 for further information and to make your reservations. Parking fee is \$3. Johnson Ferry South is located on Columns Dr. in Cobb Co. just south of the Johnson Ferry Road Bridge across the Chattahoochee River.

Expect ankle to above the knee water depths for much of this program. Please dress accordingly.
